The student's name must be on all of their supplies, coats, sweaters and all other personal belongings. Notebooks, binders, lunch boxes, and book bags, etc. should not have questionable pictures (such as rock singers, skulls, peace signs, etc.).

Each student in K4 through twelfth grade must have dedicated, indoor tennis shoes to use in the gym. No street shoes allowed. This is an extra pair that will be kept in the classroom.
